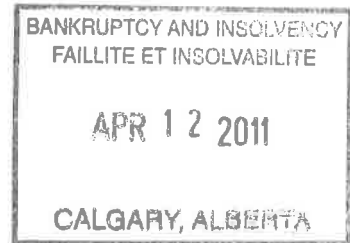

Upon the Application of Agriculture Financial Services Corporation (the "Applicant Creditor"), a creditor of the Debtor, filed April 1, 2011; and upon hearing read the Affidavit of Verification of Statements in Application for Bankruptcy Order of Gordon Blackman sworn on March 28th, 2011, filed; and upon hearing read the Affidavit of Service of Angelica Meza sworn on April 4th, 2011, filed; and upon hearing counsel for the Applicant Creditor; and upon noting that no-one appeared on behalf of 642575 Alberta Ltd. (the "Debtor") to oppose this application; and upon reading the Consent to Act as Trustee of Hardie & Kelly Inc. dated March 30th, 2011;

And upon it appearing that the following acts of bankruptcy have been committed within the 6 months preceding the filing of the Application:

- (a) The Debtor has ceased to meet its liabilities as they generally become due;
- (b) The Debtor's property is not, at a fair valuation, sufficient or, if disposed of at a fairly conducted sale under legal process, would not be sufficient to enable payment of all its obligations, due and accruing due.

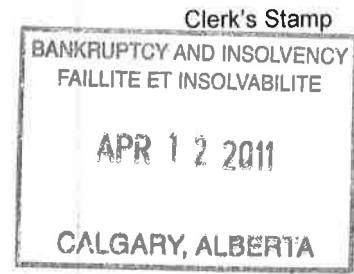
And upon being satisfied that the Debtor, the Superintendent of Bankruptcy and the Trustee have been duly served;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Debtor 642575 Alberta Ltd., operating as Ideal Rentals, of Calgary, Alberta, is hereby adjudged bankrupt and a Bankruptcy Order is hereby made against it.
2. Hardie & Kelly Inc. of Calgary, Alberta is appointed as Trustee of the estate of the bankrupt.
3. The Trustee shall forthwith give security in cash or by bond in accordance with subsection 16(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada).
4. Service of notice of the hearing of this Application upon the Debtor is deemed good and sufficient.
5. The costs of the Applicant Creditor shall be paid out of the estate of the bankrupt upon taxation thereof.
