**ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR
RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN PROCEEDING**

This matter came on for hearing on November 29, 2007 to consider the Petition for Recognition of Foreign Proceeding (“Petition for Recognition”) filed by Hardie & Kelly, Inc. as the Foreign Representative (the “Foreign Representative”) under Chapter 15 of Title 11, United States Code Annotated (the “Bankruptcy Code”). At the hearing, the Foreign Representative was represented by W. Gregory Golson and the Office of the United States Trustee was represented by Benjamin Lambers. At the hearing, counsel for the Foreign Representative represented to the Court that an agreement had been reached with counsel for Marialice T. Mulhern in her capacities as Trustee under that certain Revocable Trust Agreement of Alice L. Quinn dated March 31, 1992 and as personal representative of the Estate of Alice L. Quinn, a probate matter pending before the Circuit Court Pinellas County, Florida, Probate Division, File No. 06-3036ES, for the entry of an Order granting the Petition for Recognition. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The Petition for Recognition is hereby granted pursuant to and in accordance with Section 1517 of the Bankruptcy Code.

2. That certain foreign proceeding styled as *In the Matter of the Trusteeship of John Francis Quinn, and In the Matter of the Judicature Act (Alberta) and the Appointment of a Receiver and Manager of the Property, Assets and Undertaking of John Francis Quinn, Between Michael A. Cone, Trustee for John Francis Quinn, a Dependent Adult, as Applicant and John Francis Quinn and Dawn T. Quinn, as Respondents*, Action No. 0701-04154, before the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta Judicial District of Calgary bc, and the same hereby is, granted recognition as a foreign main proceeding pursuant to Section 1517(b)(1).

3. Hardie & Kelly, Inc. is hereby approved as the foreign representative under Chapter 15 of the Bankruptcy Code and is hereby entrusted with the administration or realization of all of the assets of John Francis Quinn located in the United States.
