Re: Proceedings under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*

On October 15, 2009, Brute Force Oil Field Hauling Inc. (the "Company") made an application for protection under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* ("CCAA") and an Initial Order (the "CCAA Order") was granted by the Honourable Justice S.J. LoVecchio of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta (the "Court"). The Court appointed Hardie & Kelly Inc. as Monitor of the Company (the "Monitor").

The CCAA Order grants the Company certain relief including the imposition of an initial *Stay of Proceedings* against the Company and its assets through to November 13, 2009. Claims against the Company for payment for goods and services supplied to the Company prior to October 15, 2009 are suspended and creditors are prohibited from continuing or taking any actions or exercising any rights against the Company absent the written consent of the Company and the Monitor, or with leave of the Court.


