**ORDER**  
**(Extension of Stay Period)**


**UPON** the application of BUDGET WASTE INC., (the "Applicant") for an Order extending the Initial Order in its entirety to and until August 14th, 2009; **AND UPON** reading the Affidavits of Jim Can, sworn March 4th, March 9th, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, May 13th, and June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009, filed, the Monitor's Reports, and the Initial Order; **AND UPON** hearing counsel for Budget Waste Inc.; **AND UPON** hearing counsel for BWI; **AND UPON** noting that DCFS Canada Corp. ("DCFS") is the Lessor under two leases dated June 24, 2005 and June 29, 2005 respectively (the "DCFS Leases"); **AND UPON** noting that the property subject to the DCFS Leases consists of: (a) a 2005 Freightliner with serial number 1FVACXCT15HU08336; (b) a 2005 Multilift with serial number 11199; (c) a 2005 Freightliner

with serial number 1FVACXCT15HU08337; and (d) a 2005 Multilift with serial number 93641511022 (Collectively, the "DCFS Vehicles"); IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. THAT the time for service and hearing of the Notice of Motion and materials in support thereof, including the manner of service, be and is hereby abridged to the date of service and service is deemed good and sufficient;
2. THAT the Initial Order in these proceedings, granted March 4th, 2009, be and is hereby extended in its entirety to **9:00 o'clock, August 14th, 2009** ("Extension Date").
3. THAT service of this Order may be affected by electronic or facsimile transmission.
4. THAT the documentation evidencing the transfer of, and/or entitlement to, the owned and leased assets identified in the Monitor's Report as owned or leased by Able, Baker and Cem Can, which assets are being used by Budget Waste Inc. And have been and continue to be included in the assets of Budget Waste Inc., be completed by Budget Waste Inc. on or before Monday, June 29, 2009.
5. THAT Budget Waste Inc. Not be allowed to pre-bill customers unless a mechanism satisfactory to the Monitor is implemented to hold such funds and protect the position of such customers in the event that Budget Waste Inc. Is unable to fulfill its obligations.

6. THAT Budget Waste Inc. Provide by July 15, 2009, such documentation as may be required to satisfy the Monitor that it has met its projections for the month of June and/or that its position is not deteriorating. In the event that the information is not satisfactory to the Monitor, the Monitor is entitled to bring an Application to have the Stay lifted prior to the requested Extension date.
7. THAT Budget Waste Inc. undertake a detailed review of its assets and operations and provide a plan to utilize necessary assets and dispose of surplus assets on or before July 15, 2009, failing which the Monitor is entitled to bring an Application to have the Stay lifted prior to the requested Extension Date.
8. THAT custody and possession of the DCFS Vehicles be immediately turned over to DCFS. DCFS shall hold the DCFS Vehicles at a Freightliner dealership in either Calgary or Edmonton pending the further direction of this Court. DCFS shall advise the Monitor and the Applicant as to the address of the storage location prior to taking possession of the DCFS Vehicles. While the DCFS Vehicles are in DCFS's custody and possession, DCFS shall provide for their storage at no charge and shall be responsible for providing insurance coverage for the DCFS Vehicles at DCFS's cost.

9. THAT DCFS's custody and possession of the DCFS Vehicles shall be without prejudice to the rights of any other party in these proceedings in connection to the DCFS Vehicles.

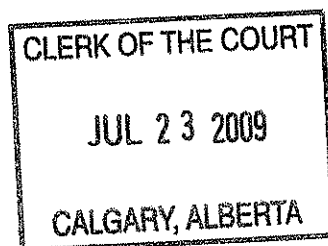
