Re: Proceedings under the Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act (the "CCAA")

By Order of the Honourable Justice S.J. Lovecchio granted May 22, 2009 in the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta Action No. 0901-02873 ("Claims Order"), Hardie & Kelly Inc. in its capacity as Monitor of the Companies (the "Monitor") has been authorized to conduct a claims procedure Companies. Any creditor (i) having a claim against the Companies **arising on or before March 5, 2009** of any nature whatsoever, including an unsecured, secured, contingent or unliquidated claim, (a "Pre-Filing Claim") and/or (ii) having a claim against the Companies arising after March 5, 2009 as a result of the disclaimer or repudiation, after March 5, 2009, of any contract, lease, employment agreement or other arrangement or agreement of any nature whatsoever, whether oral or written, and any amending agreement related thereto (a "Subsequent Claim") is required to file with the Monitor a *Notice of Claim* in order to participate in any voting or distributions associated with the Companies' CCAA proceedings. The deadline for filing claims with the Monitor is June 23, 2009.

You are not required to file a claim in the event any indebtedness to you that may have existed as of March 5, 2009 has since been satisfied by way of payment from Deloitte & Touche Inc. in its capacity as Receiver of CSEI's Participating Interest in Block 5(c) Trinidad and Tobago.

Enclosed you will find copies of the following documents necessary to submit a claim if required:

- Notice to Creditors; and
- Instruction Letter and Notice of Claim form.
