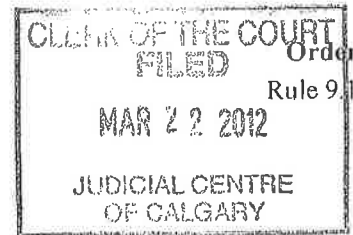



**UPON THE JOINT APPLICATION** of counsel for the Plaintiff, Summerhill Investment Corporation and 1027493 Alberta Inc. (collectively, the "Primary Secured Parties") and counsel for EION Inc. and EION Wireless Inc. (collectively, "EION"); **AND UPON HEARING** counsel for the Primary Secured Parties, EION and Hardie & Kelly Inc., in its capacity as Receiver of the Defendant (the "Receiver"); **AND UPON NOTING** the consent of counsel to the Primary Secured Parties, EION and Receiver endorsed hereon; **AND UPON BEING ADVISED** of the consent of 2019658 Ontario Limited;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**


1. Subject to paragraph 2 below, all funds distributed by the Receiver in this proceeding shall be paid as follows, in the following priorities and amounts:
  - (a) First, to the Plaintiff up to the amount of its proven claim of \$1,119,567.34;
  - (b) Second, to Summerhill Investment Corporation up to the amount of its proven claim of \$760,000;
  - (c) Third, to EION Wireless Inc. up to the amount of its proven claim of \$611,278.25;
  - (d) Fourth, to 1027493 Alberta Inc. up to the amount of its proven claim of \$231,781.78;
  - (e) Fifth, to 2019658 Ontario Limited up to the amount of its proven claim of \$10,000; and
  - (f) Sixth, to all other creditors in accordance with their legal entitlements and priorities.
  
2. The priorities referenced in paragraph 1 above are and shall remain subordinate to the priorities prescribed in paragraphs 17 and 20 of the August 3, 2011 Order of Mr. Justice P.R. Jeffrey in this proceeding, and any other amounts that may, by operation of law, be in priority to the security of the parties referenced in paragraph 1.

3. The Receiver is hereby authorized and empowered to make distributions to appropriate persons in accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order.
4. Immediately upon the Plaintiff's receipt of its first distribution from the Receiver, the Plaintiff shall pay \$50,000 to Field LLP, counsel to EION, which payment shall not be considered a deduction from EION's lawful entitlement referenced in paragraph 1 above.
5. The Plaintiff, Eion and the Receiver may seek further advice and directions from this Honourable Court in respect of the terms of this Order.
6. Service of this Order by email, facsimile, registered mail, courier or personal delivery to the persons listed on the Service List (as that term is defined in the Application and as may be amended or modified from time to time) shall constitute good and sufficient service of this Order, and no persons other than those listed on the Service List are entitled to be served with a copy of this Order.


