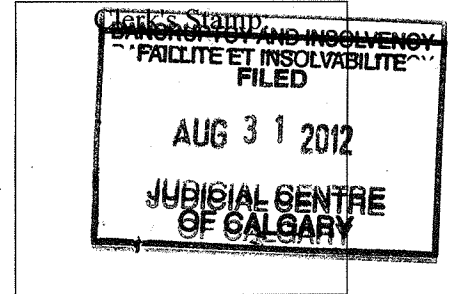

ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION of Poynt Corporation ("Poynt"), AND UPON HAVING read the Application filed by Poynt and the Affidavit of Andrew Osis (the "Osis Affidavit"), sworn August 30, 2012, the Order of this Court, dated August 15, 2012, wherein this Court granted and approved Poynt's authority to borrow interim financing (the "Second DIP Financing") and granted a charge (the "Second DIP Lender's Charge") to secure the Second DIP Facility (the "Second DIP Order"), AND UPON HEARING counsel for Poynt and all other interested parties present; AND UPON noting the consent of counsel for Intertainment Media Inc. to the within Order; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The time for service of the Application and all materials in support is hereby abridged to the date of actual service and service is hereby deemed good and sufficient.

2. The 30-day period of time within which Poynt is required to file a proposal to its creditors with the Official Receiver, under section 50.4 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, R.S.C. 1985 c. B-3, shall be and is hereby extended by 11 days, from August 30, 2012 to and including September 10, 2012.
3. Poynt is granted the authority to borrow the further amount of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand (\$220,000.00) Dollars from Gris Gris, LLC, a Delaware LLC (the "**Second DIP Lender**") by way of an agreement to amend (the "**Amending Agreement**") the Second DIP Financing, dated August 30, 2012, (the Second DIP Financing together with the Amending Agreement are referred to herein as the "**Amended Second DIP Financing**").
4. The terms of the Amending Agreement and the Amended Second DIP Financing, attached as Exhibit "B" to the Osis Affidavit, be and are hereby approved.
5. The Second DIP Lender's Charge, originally created by virtue of the Second DIP Order in the amount of \$80,000.00, plus all other amounts owing to the Second DIP Lender pursuant to the August 15, 2012 Commitment Letter, shall be increased to a total of \$300,000.00, plus all other amounts owing to the Second DIP Lender pursuant to the Amended Second DIP Financing.
6. The respective ranking of the any and all outstanding Court-ordered charges on Poynt's Property and the security interests in Poynt's Property shall remain the same as set out in the Order granted in the within proceedings on August 15, 2012.
7. The filing, registration or perfection of the Second DIP Lender's Charge shall not be required, and the Second DIP Lender's Charge shall be enforceable for all purposes, including as against any right, title or interest filed, registered, recorded or perfected subsequent to the Second DIP Lender's Charge coming into existence, notwithstanding any such failure to file, register, record or perfect.
8. The Agreement referenced at paragraph 9 of the Osis Affidavit between Poynt and Intertainment, dated August 30, 2012, is hereby approved.

9. Service of this Order shall be deemed to have been achieved by posting a copy of this Order on the website of the NOI Trustee and by delivering a copy of this Order to those parties listed on the Service List prepared by counsel for Poynt.
