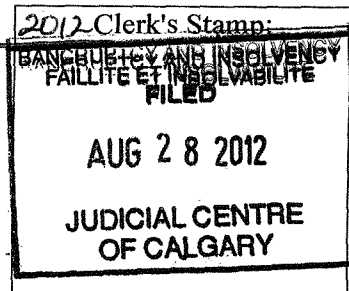



ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION of Poynt Corporation ("Poynt"), AND UPON HAVING read the Application by Poynt and the Affidavit of Andrew Osis, sworn August 27, 2012 (the "Osis Affidavit"), AND UPON HEARING counsel for Poynt and all other interested parties present; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The time for service of the Application and all materials in support is hereby abridged to the date of actual service and service is hereby deemed good and sufficient.
2. The 30-day period of time within which Poynt is required to file a proposal to its creditors with the Official Receiver, under section 50.4 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, R.S.C. 1985 c. B-3, shall be and is hereby extended by three days, to August 30, 2012.
